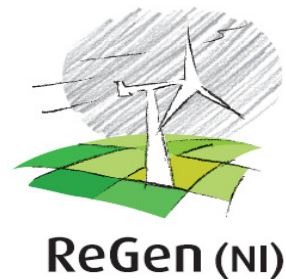

ReGen (NI) Newsletter, June 2011.



ReGen (NI) are pleased to announce that the EVOCO E10 (MCS approved) has been added to our range of Micro Generators. The E10 is a 10Kw machine generating an estimated annual 34,000kwh at 6m/s. The E10 joins our established and reliable EVANCE R9000 (MCS approved) 5kw wind turbine. We now have 55 of the EVANCE type machines generating environmentally friendly power in the Province. We emphasise that both machines are MCS approved. This is very important as this is a prerequisite for the NIE domestic grant and the payment of ROCs to clients. (More information on Northern Ireland Renewable Obligation Certificates (NIROCs) below)

From 1 April 2011, microgenerators (up to and including 50kW) seeking first time accreditation under the NIRO (for onshore wind or solar photovoltaic panels) must use the Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS). Each new application for NIROCs **must** include a copy of the MCS certificate associated with the installation. **ReGen (NI) is a MCS approved installer.** NIROCs provide a sizable income. Since April 2010 quadruple ROC payments are available for small wind turbines paying 16.92p for each kWh generated. This payment is additional to exported units to the grid, current rate 5.49p/kWh and additional the consumption of generated power used at home saving 14.8p/kWh.



As a member of the REAL Assurance Scheme, ReGen (NI) abide by the REAL Assurance Scheme Consumer Code. It covers all the factors that contribute to a high standard of consumer service, before, during and after a contract is agreed. These include: clear information on the systems planned and their performance, acceptable sales and marketing techniques, arrangements for installing and connecting the system, the selection and quality of goods supplied, details of the conditions of business that apply, the standard of any installation and other on-site work, guarantees, and any maintenance and after-sales services needed, what action will be taken to deal with any problems, and arrangements for monitoring and continuously improving the Code.
